# Asking Questions about a Text

## **Ethical Questions**

## **Contradictions**

Look for situations when, *without explanation as to why*, a character acts the opposite way of how he/she truly thinks.

How would the meaning of this sentence change if the author had substituted the word "word from quote" with a similar word like \_\_\_\_\_? What are the connotations of word #1 and how are they different from the connotations of word #2? How do these differences affect the tone (author's attitude) or mood of this scene?

# Unanswered Questions (Ask after you have FINISHED the book)

- When <u>(describe the situation, setting & speaker</u>), what questions are left unanswered for the reader? Why do you think the author did not answer these questions? Are there clues in the text that hint at the answer and if so what do you think those answers are?
- Why do you think the text does not reveal / tell the reader
  ?
